We use the following scripture to determine expectations around appropriate clothing guidelines:

“So let’s stop condemning each other. Decide instead to live in such a way that you will not cause another believer to stumble and fall.”

Romans 14:13 NLT

“And I want women to be modest in their appearance. They should wear decent and appropriate clothing and not draw attention to themselves by the way they fix their hair or by wearing gold or pearls or expensive clothes. For women who claim to be devoted to God should make themselves attractive by the good things they do.”

1 Timothy 2:9-10 NLT

WHAT TO WEAR

Comfortable, Modest Clothing

- Pants
- T shirt
- Tank tops w/ 1” straps
- Shorts at least 2” below bottom
- Leggings w/ bottom coverage (long shirt or wrap around waist)
- Overalls and rompers with appropriate undershirt
- Skirt length - mid-thigh or longer
- Sleepwear should follow the above guidelines (Spandex/Sport Shorts may be used for pjs)

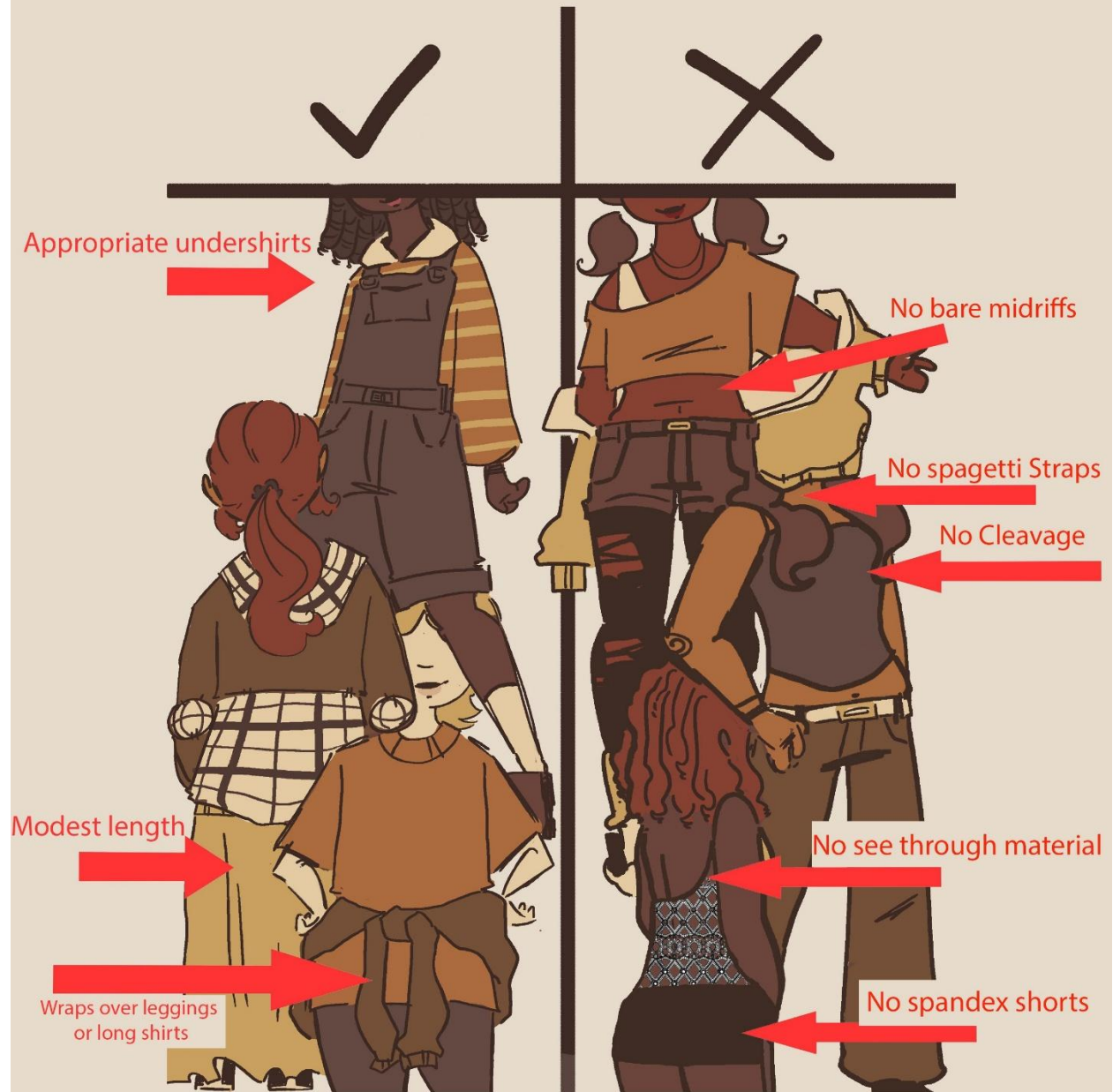
WHAT NOT TO WEAR

Revealing Clothing: Clothing that exposes bare midribs, underwear, or cleavage is not permitted.

Clothing with references to drugs, alcohol, sex, profanity or anything demonic

- Avoid showing cleavage
- Spaghetti straps
- Undergarments / bras showing
- Spandex / Sports Shorts / tight boy shorts
- Anything see-through
- Leggings without bottom coverage
- Short shorts (must have 2” below bottom)
- Crop tops
- Tube top/ strapless shirts

HOW TO RESPOND

Any Team Member who notices what they believe is inappropriate dress should notify the Board Rep, Clergy or Adult ALD to determine next steps. Do NOT speak with anyone else regarding the matter.

- BR, Clergy or ALD will ask Sponsor or person who knows the person to speak with the person
- If sponsor or other familiar person is unavailable, ask a youth ALD or Table Leader speak with the person
- If appropriate clothing is not available, offer a change of clothes if no other option is available
